



REBUILD UKRAINE

The humanitarian crisis created by the Russian War of 2022 in Ukraine is immense and will last for decades. To contribute to the resolution of this crisis, **REBUILD UKRAINE** was established by influential Ukrainian American business leaders and educators, and their American colleagues. **REBUILD UKRAINE**'s mission is to work directly with partners in Eastern Europe to provide immediate humanitarian aid to Ukraine, including its refugees and residents, as well as to offer support and education for children affected by the war.

IMMEDIATE HUMANITARIAN PROGRAMS

In war time, **REBUILD UKRAINE** is able to leverage partnerships in Lithuania to deliver the most critically needed aid to those suffering in Ukraine – on tight timelines, and in a manner highly responsive to conditions on the ground. Partners source supplies in Lithuania and then drive them directly to contacts in Ukraine. This strategy is highly cost-effective and is creating a strategic support network, whereby refugees and children affected by war can find safe passage to Lithuania and other EU countries.

REBUILD UKRAINE volunteers have evacuated civilians from war-torn areas to safety and have assisted refugee families with finding housing abroad. We have delivered food and other vital supplies to the areas suffering from food shortages. We have equipped Ukraine's voluntary ground defense units with protective gear, such as uniforms and boots. We have delivered life-saving medical devices, such as tourniquets, which stop bleeding from wounds sustained in battle. Finally, we are purchasing used SUVs that will serve as emergency vehicles in different situations, including the work of the voluntary rescue workers.

LONG-TERM VISION & PROGRAMS

Even as we respond immediately in a time of crisis, **REBUILD UKRAINE** has the long-term good of the country and its people in mind. We are acting strategically to position the organization's work for influence and results over the long term. In peace time, **Rebuild Ukraine** will focus on:

STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIPS

REBUILD UKRAINE's partners in Eastern Europe are:

SemanticForce Foundation (Kaunas, Lithuania).

The Foundation, which is presently being incorporated, provides logistical support, volunteer support, acquisition of food, medical supplies and equipment, as well as protective gear and supplies. In peace time, the Foundation will focus on the work with the orphanages.

Pirogov Military Hospital (Kyiv, Ukraine).

The hospital is the main medical facility in Ukraine's capital for the treatment of critically wounded. Rebuild Ukraine supplies the hospital with medical supplies and emergency vehicles for the volunteers who deliver the wounded from the battle field.

Kyiv Natural-Scientific Lyceum #145 (Kyiv, Ukraine)

The Lyceum is a prep high school for children who go on to pursue STEM-related fields in college. The Lyceum will be an ideal partner for Allen Academy.

REBUILD UKRAINE's partners in the US are:

Allen Academy (Bryan, Texas)

Allen Academy is an established prep school, including a boarding program for international students, and it plans to admit Ukrainian students as soon as possible. The Academy will partner with Rebuild Ukraine to select high school students studying at the Kyiv Natural-Scientific Lyceum.

FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES

From February 25, 2022 to March 14, 2022, **REBUILD UKRAINE** has raised over \$130,000 from 100+ donors. 100% of the donated funds went directly to buying and delivering the emergency supplies described above. The goal is to raise an additional \$500,000 over the next three months and to double the donor base. 100% of these funds will go directly to front-line work and will undoubtedly save – whether through direct evacuation or provision of medicine or equipment with protective gear – thousands of lives.

REBUILD UKRAINE is being incorporated in the State of Minnesota as a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization.

OFFICERS OF **THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS**



Paul Gavrilyuk (President) is the Aquinas Chair in Theology and Philosophy at the University of St Thomas, St Paul, Minnesota. An internationally respected public speaker, he has five years of experience in the non-profit sphere and is the founding president of the International Orthodox Theological Association. He was born in Kyiv, Ukraine and came to the US in 1993. His elderly parents, who fled from Kyiv in February 2022, are now refugees in Lithuania.
